Forging Ahead With Winning Strides

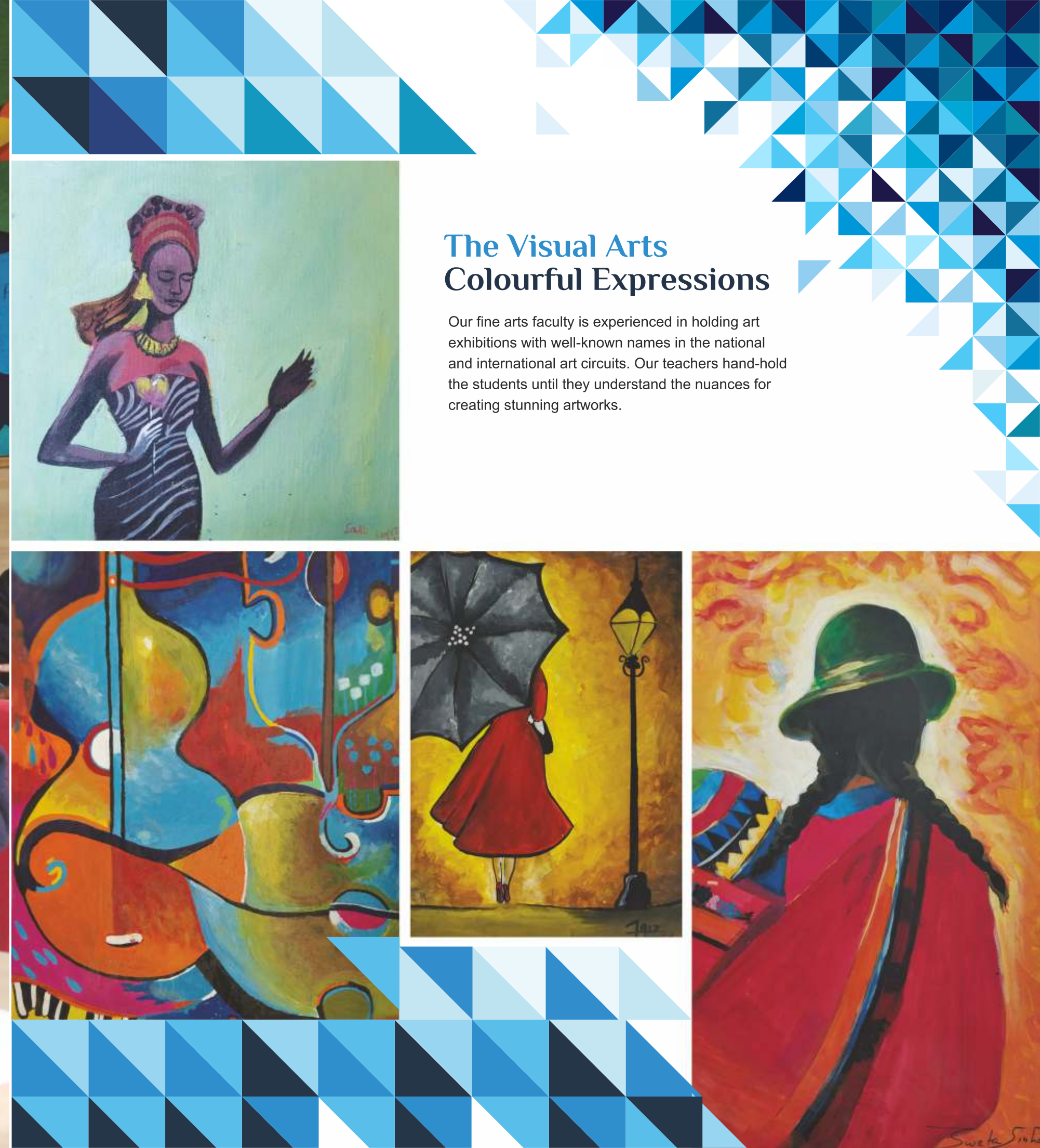
- At Aster, we consider sports activities with great responsibility. Our students are trained and prepared for zonal, national and international sports events and competitions.

La Crème is a premier playschool that has been offering valuable services in the fields of childcare and child education tailor-made for the formative years. The faculty members work well with children and are adept at moulding their behaviour helping them to grow into strong-willed and balanced individuals.

A home away from home, La Crème offers educative services through detailed, spacious infrastructure, enabling learning through fun and games. Varied group and individual activities are strategically included in the curriculum to impart valuable life lessons through simple but memorable and creative physical activities.

Our Unique Teaching Methodology

Fun and frolic are resorted to, to impart valuable life lessons. Languages and cognitive skills, number counting and mathematical abilities, listening abilities, creative perception building, understanding the environment and surroundings, and more, are all imparted through varied activity oriented teaching methods. Lollipop making with clay:

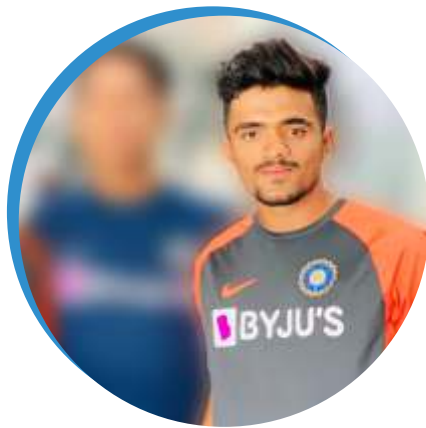

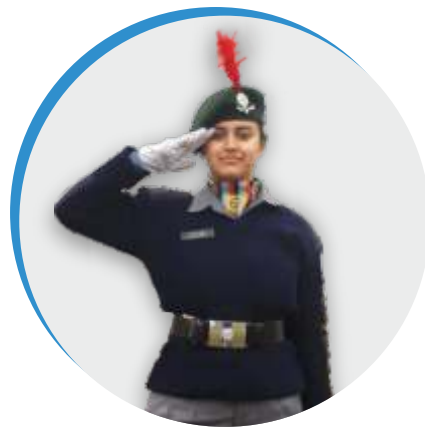
